The teams must belong to an ISU Member (Rule 130, paragraph 7), and the ages must be within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. All skaters must qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102 and participation and citizenship requirements according to Rule 109.

Judges & Officials:	The judges, referees, technical specialists, technical controllers, data and replay operators will be nominated by the Deutsche Eislauf-Union (DEU). Each participating country may nominate one synchronized skating Judge, listed on the ISU list of Referees and Judges for Synchronized Skating 2022/2023. In case of too many nominated Judges the organizer will draw the panel of Judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all ISU members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw. Please be aware that all Judges must be nominated before the closing date for final entry on 10th of December 2022. The panel is composed for each category of: 1 Referee 1 Referee's Assistant Ice Level 5-7 Judges 1 Technical Controller 2 Data/Replay operator Travel, accommodation, and meals will be paid for the Technical panel and the Referee by the organizing committee as well as the accommodation and meals for the judges.
Judges & Technical Panel Meeting:	The initial judges meeting and initial technical panel meeting are planned to take place at the club room of the Neuss ice rink at 12:00 h on Friday, 10 th of February 2023.
Draw & Starting Order:	The starting order will be determined by draw. The draw will be done on Friday the 10th of February 2023 and will be published on www.cup-of-neuss.de not later than 23:59 PM. The draw for the Free Skating for the categories Junior ISU, Senior ISU and Senior Elite 12 will be after the last short program of the day at the ice rink.
Opening Ceremony:	On Saturday the 11th of February their will be an opening ceremony on the ice rink before the competition. Each team is requested to participate with 2 skaters. We invite all teams to attend at the opening ceremony completely on the grandstand.
Victory Ceremony:	A victory ceremony will be held right after the last skating program of the day. Trophies will be awarded to the top three teams in each category. Medals will be presented to all skaters (1 per competitor) of teams. All skaters of all teams are invited to take part in the closing ceremony on the ice.
